### CITY FACTS

- **Norwegian Aviation Museum:** 10 000m<sup>2</sup> of Norwegian and international aviation history. The museum is one of Bodø's finest attractions, and perhaps the most exciting museum in all of Norway. The unique building, which resembles a gigantic propeller, houses a variety of exhibitions and two tempting flight simulators.
- **Saltstraumen:** The strongest tidal current in the world, only 30 km from Bodø. Every six hours, 400 Million m<sup>3</sup> of water speeds up to 20 knots rushing under the mighty Saltstraumen Bridge. Saltstraumen is the angler's paradise and is famous for its abundance of fish, including cod, saithe, wolfish, halibut and salmon.
- **Kjerringøy old trading post:** An excursion to the "island" Kjerringøy is a must when you visit Bodø! This mountainous peninsula offers varied hill walking, challenging rock climbing, lakes and streams teeming with fish, white beaches and an idyllic shoreline with undisturbed coves and narrow.
