- **Hjejlen** - take a tour on the lakes with the old stream boat Hjejlen. Hjejlen was the first piece of culture set out on the lake in 1861.
- **Silkeborg Art Museum** - the artist Asger Jorn puts Silkeborg on the map as a centre for the art. See the collection of his international and Danish art.
- **Silkeborg Museum** - see the moor corps Tollund Man who is over 2,400 years old. He can be seen along with other displays about the history of the region.
